2 As regards interim relief, it is agreed between the parties, through
the counsel, that the Respondent will initially join services of the
Petitioners as a clerk in the canteen run in the multiplex of the Petitioners.
The Petitioners will send the Respondent for computer training which is
required to work as a booking clerk in present situation. After the
Respondent completes the requisite training, the Petitioners will give
work of the booking clerk to the Respondent.

3 In view of this consensus, there shall be stay to the direction to pay
back wages.

4 The learned counsel for the parties state that the Respondent will attend the office of the Petitioners at 10.00 a.m. on 11 August 2014 to join duties as a clerk in the canteen, as above.
